### Antony Green

Antony Green has worked on election coverage for nearly two decades. He has worked on every federal, state and territory contest since his first election with the Australian Broadcasting Corporation (ABC) in Queensland in 1989. He has been part of the ABC on-air election panel since 1993. In all, Antony has worked on nearly 40 elections with the ABC.

Antony has a Bachelor of Science in mathematics and computing, and a Bachelor of Economics with Honours in politics. Before joining the ABC he worked as a data analyst in the computing industry and for a polling company. Antony designed the ABC's current election night computer system which, in his capable hands on election night, has set new benchmarks in the speed and accuracy of calling results.

Antony also produces regular publications on electoral matters for the New South Wales Parliamentary Library. As part of the 150th anniversary of self-government in NSW, Antony co-edited "The Electoral Atlas of New South Wales", a book that maps the history of the state's politics. He is currently working on an historical project to properly document the state's elections in the period before Federation.
